

## 4Dmentor.com Customized Training - How It Works

4Dmentor.com Customized Training is a unique concept – the “Virtual one-on-one Classroom” - which is now possible because of today's high-speed broadband technology. Now, you can get exactly the personalized, customized 4D training you need, when you need it, where you need it (in your own home or office), at a cost that is far less than the traditional cost of on-site training (travel-expenses-plus-training fees). All "classroom sessions" are via Webex, and all class meeting schedules are customized to fit the student's needs. Each student attends the two-day class from the comfort of his or her own home or office. There are no airfare expenses, no hotel expenses, and no non-productive days due to travel time. More information:

- Most classes are two days in length.
- We will proceed as if you had traveled to California to attend the class, meaning that you should plan on devoting at least seven hours a day, both days, to the class.
- The student should plan to spend two hours of each day on the phone with the instructor, using a simultaneous telephone/Webex. Webex allows the instructor or the student to be the “Presenter,” which means that either person can observe what is happening on the other person's computer. This is the ultimate in one-on-one training.
- The rest of the day (approximately 5 more hours), the student should devote to course work in the virtual classroom, doing the exercises and preparing for the live Webex lessons.
- You will be able to download the training materials (PDF documents and example databases) the day before the course, so you can do some advance preparation, if desired (advance preparation is optional; other than the pre-requisites, which will be listed on the web site, no other advance preparation is required).
- All example databases will be compatible with version 6.7.X and higher: 6.7.2, 6.8.4, or 2003.1. You should own a Developer License, because you will need 4D Compiler and 4D Insider, as well as 4D itself.
- The first live session will be one hour in the morning at a mutually-agreed time. During that session, we will go through the day's study materials, and you will ask any questions that you might have about the first assignment.
- Anytime during the training days, you can send me e-mails. The instructor will answer all e-mails within one hour of the time received.
- The second live session will be one hour in the afternoon at a mutually-agreed time. This session will be similar to the morning session: via Webex, the student and the instructor will be able to observe each others' screens. Simultaneously, they will be connected via a telephone voice line
- Students from outside the United States are welcome; however, if the student is located outside the United States, Canada, and Western Europe, telephone calls will be at the student's expense. The instructor and the student will work out mutually-agreeable telephone times, so that they both can get some sleep. Webex will work the same for all students around the world: if you have a high-speed broadband connection, you can connect to Webex.
- Upon successful completion of the class, the student will receive, via postal mail, a Certificate of Completion, just as if he or she had attended a live class.

- The cost of a two-day course is approximately \$699.00, less a 15% discount for non-profit and educational customers. Because there are no travel expenses (airfare, hotel, food), this will be a significant savings compared to on-site classes. For example, if a student travels from the East Coast or the West Coast of the United States, to a 2-day course in Chicago:

## Notes:

1. Even though we have assumed exactly the same cost for the course itself, the total costs (including travel and meals) for a normal on-site course, involving travel, are more than twice the costs of a 4D Boot Camp course.
2. Since there will be only one student for each one-hour virtual session, the student will actually get more personal attention than he or she might get in a classroom with (for example) seven other people in the class.
3. Traveling to a class location always involves at least one day of extra travel time, because the student needs to arrive on the day or evening before the class. If the travel is coast-to-coast, the student will need one full day to go to the course site, and another full day to return home. So for a two-day course, the student is spending one or two extra days away from home. 4DMentor.com training eliminates this extra travel time.
